Humid Weather Precaution!!!

Welcome to Spring! Starting from March, Hong Kong weather may become very humid. Don't want your apartment or your belongings to go mouldy? Check the following tips!

1. Keeping all windows and glass doors of the balconies of your apartments and those along the staircases closed as far as possible. This is to avoid humidity from getting into the building
2. When you bath or cook, ensure you close the door and open exhaust fan. This is to ensure that humid air will be discharged properly to the outside of the apartment!
3. Turn on AC will help to keep indoor air dry.
4. Make use of moisture absorber. You could buy these from family store or supermarket, work well in wardrobe to keep clothes dry.
5. What should you do if you find mold growing inside your apartment? **You should clean the mold with diluted bleach IMMEDIATELY and inform OCHS of the situation so we will follow up.**
